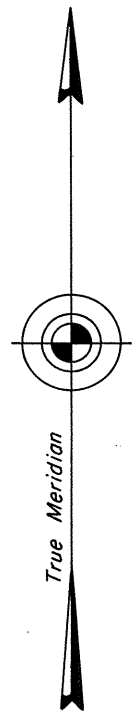
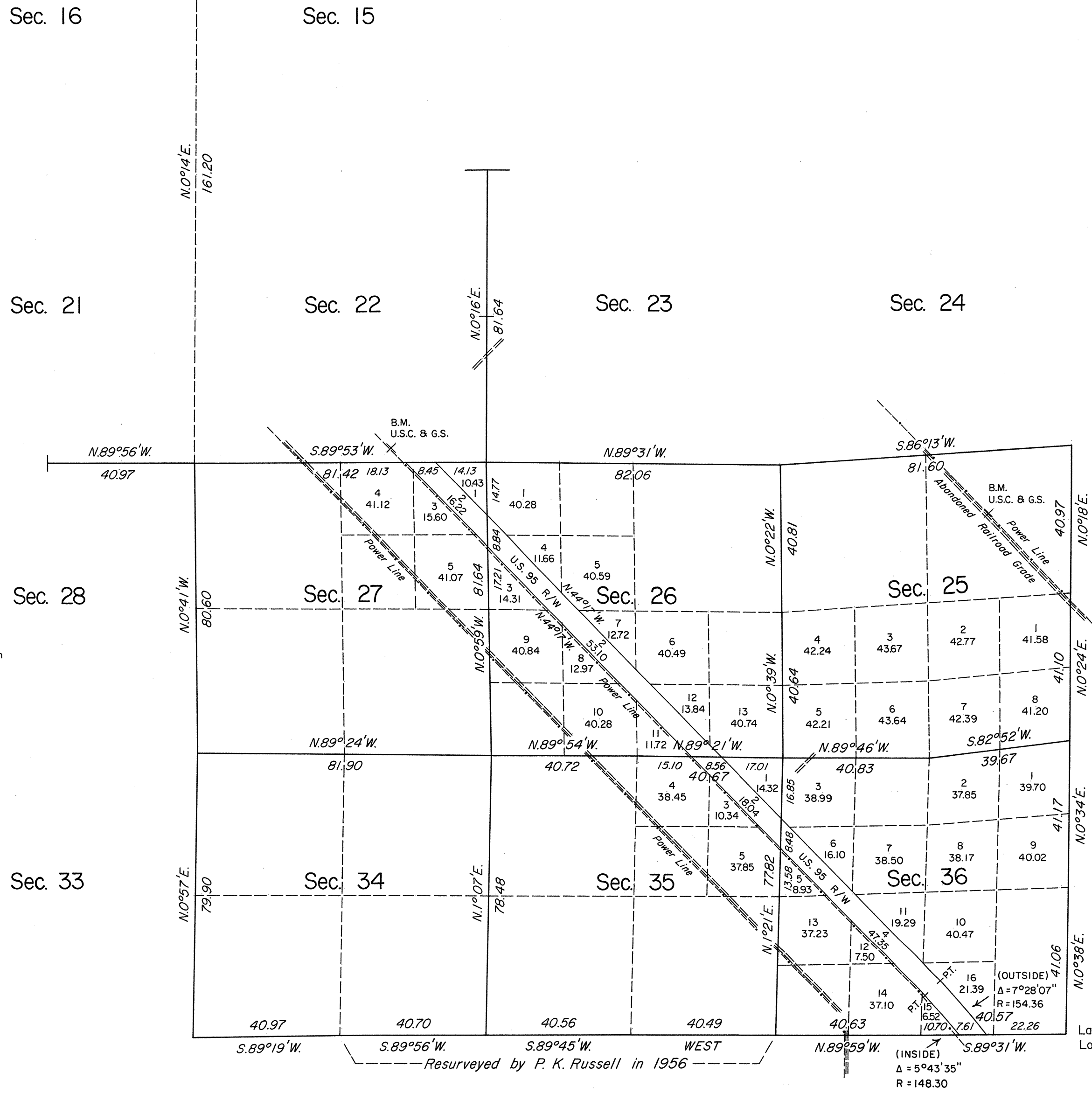


TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 59 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south and east boundaries and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 18 S., R. 59 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved February 18, 1882.
