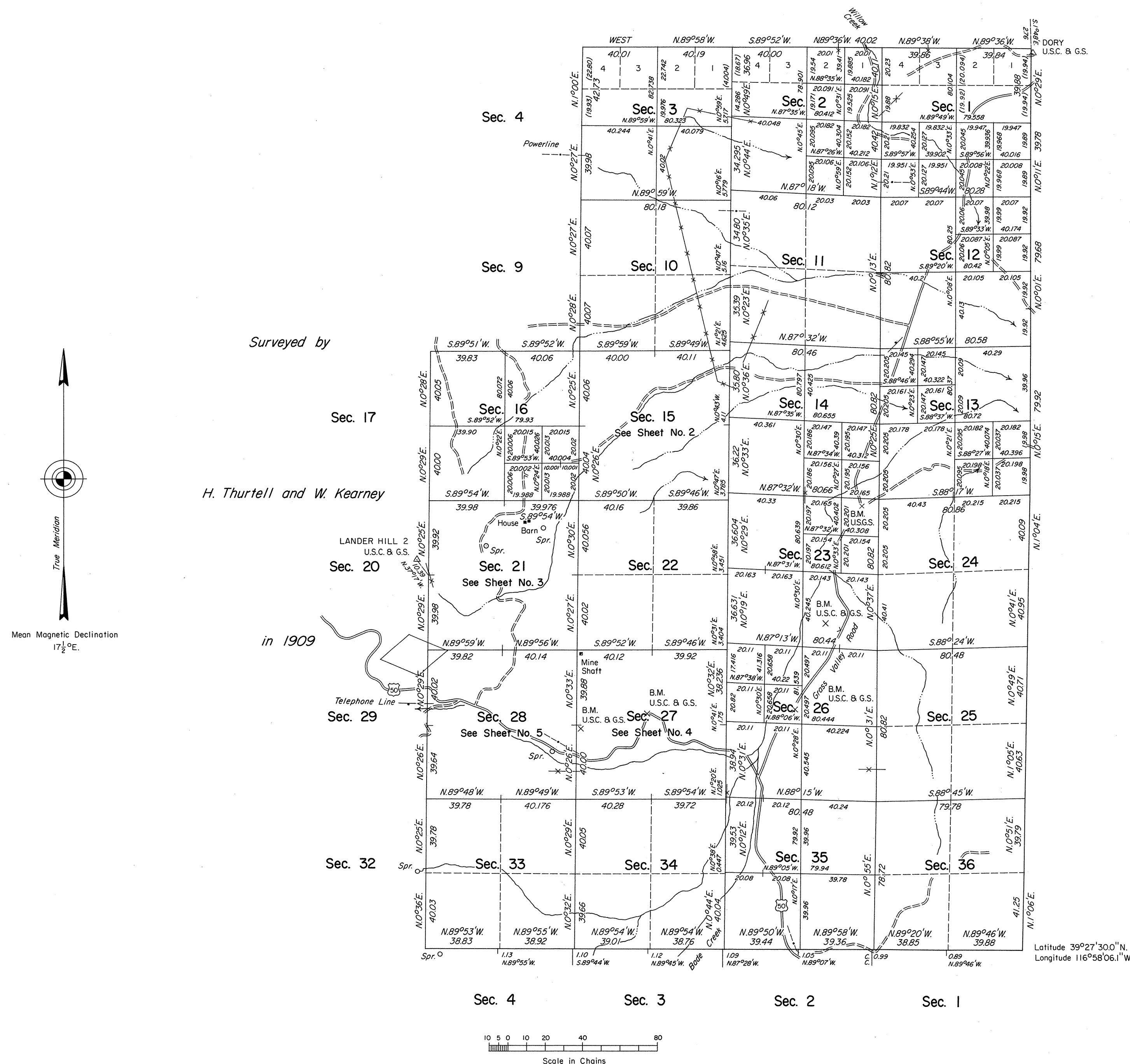


TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 44 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat, in five sheets, represents the dependent resurvey of the east boundary, portions of the north and south boundaries, and portions of the subdivisional lines, and the retracement and remonumentation of certain corners of Mineral Survey No. 3729 designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of certain secs. T. 19 N., R. 44 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved October 25, 1875, and March 4, 1910.

Survey executed by Neil R. Forsyth, James M. McNeely, and David E. Provost, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning May 15, 1979, and completed October 24, 1979, pursuant to Special Instructions dated May 2, 1979, for Group No. 573, Nevada.
