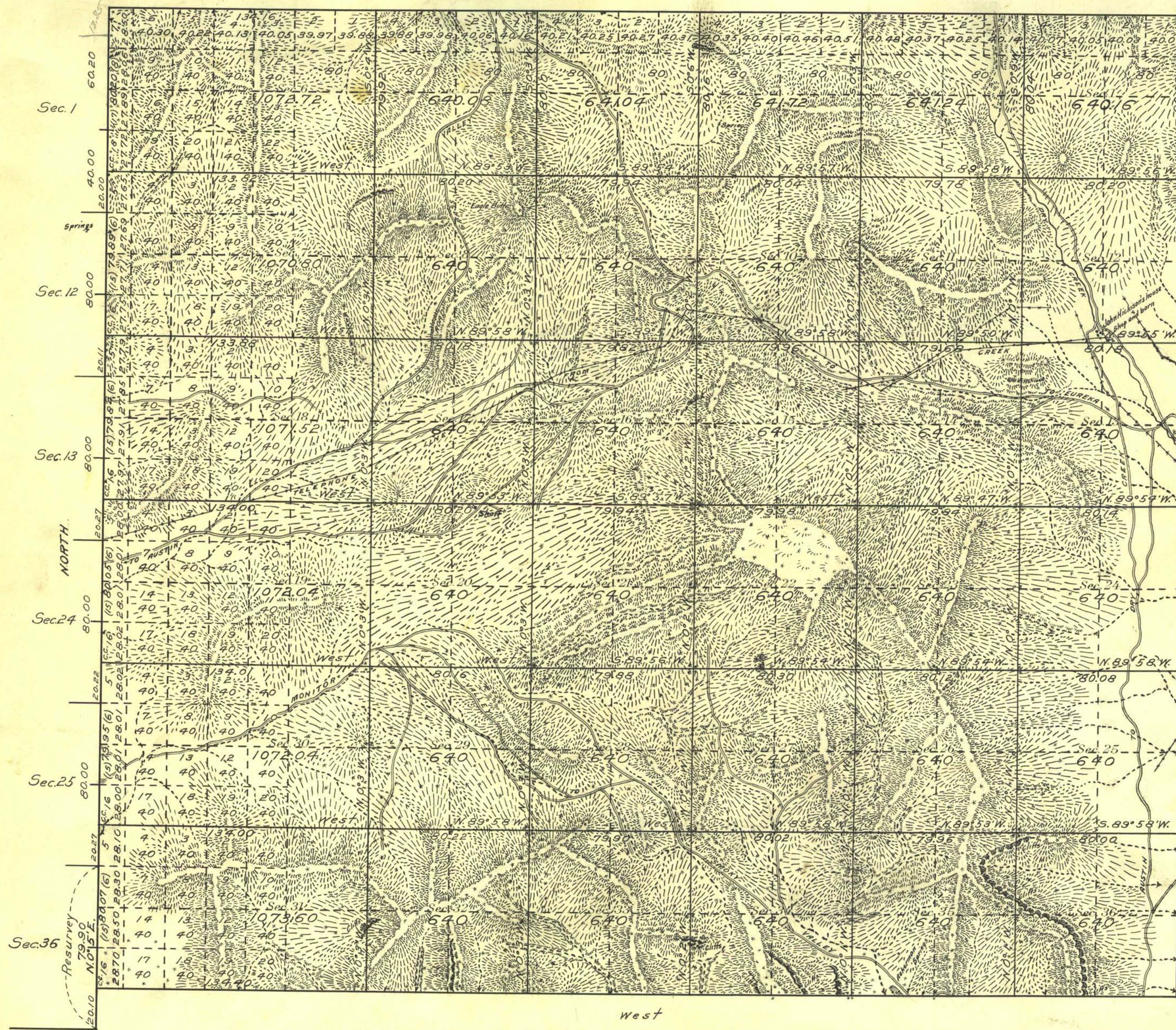


Township N<sup>o</sup> 19 North, Range N<sup>o</sup> 46 East, Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada
