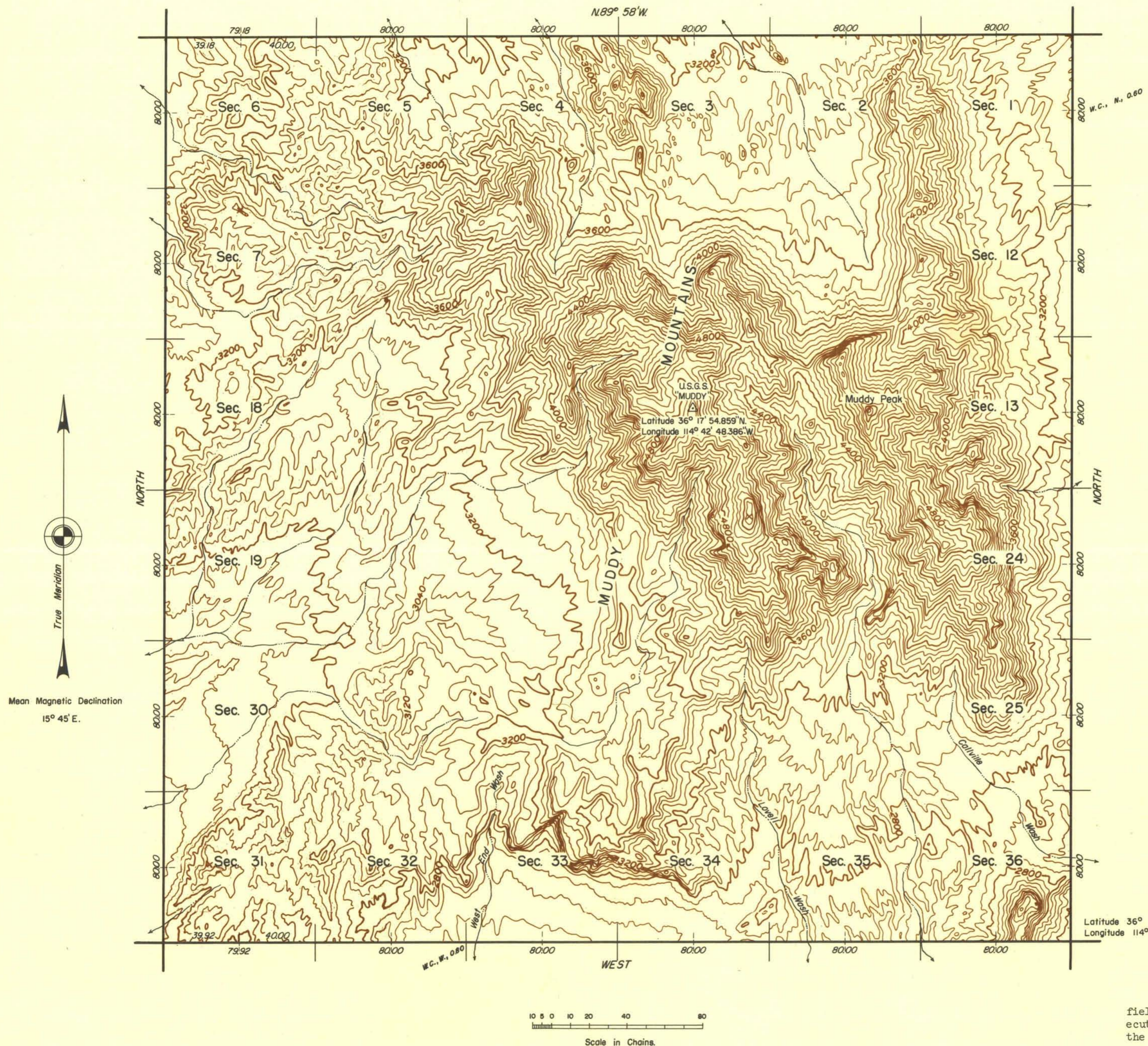


TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 65 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA



The south and west boundaries were surveyed by W. H. Myrick in 1882 and independently resurveyed by J. W. Hardison, Wilson McConkie and J. Glenn Dyer in 1938. The north boundary was surveyed by Craig P. Sylvester concurrently under this same group.

Survey of the east boundary of T. 19 S., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, executed by Craig P. Sylvester, January 7 to 8, 1959 under special instructions dated June 5, 1958 for Group 373, Nevada.

Topography on this plat furnished by the U. S. Geological Survey. For additional topography along surveyed lines, reference is made to the field notes. Contour interval is 80 feet.
