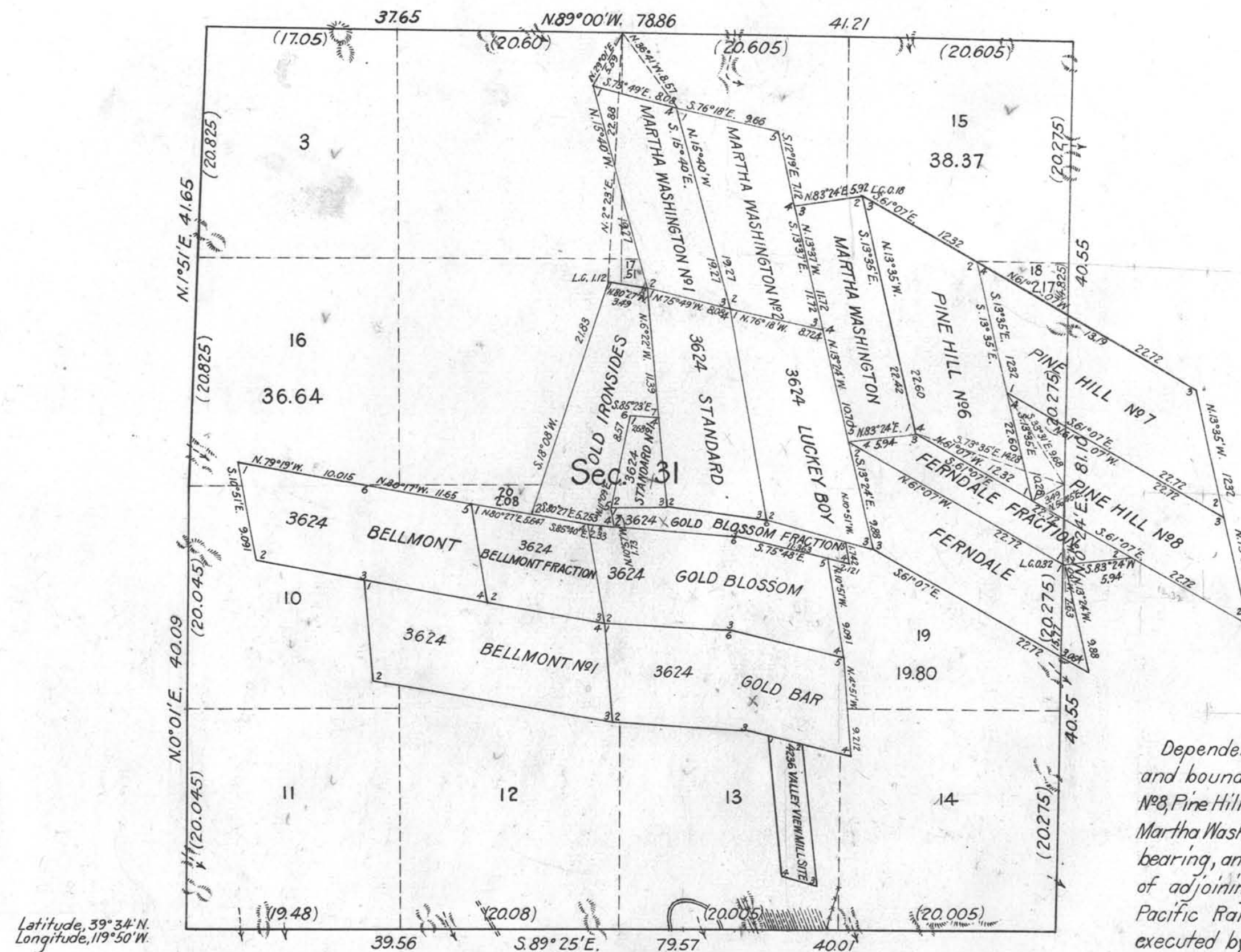


TOWNSHIP N^o20 NORTH, RANGE N^o19 EAST OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

Swanholm, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, June 15 - July 25, 1929, under special instructions dated March 3, 1925 for Group 126, Nevada, authorized by Commissioners letter "E" dated Jan. 12, 1925.
