March 25th 1879

It is hereby ordered that the tract of Country known and occupied as the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation in Nevada be surveyed by Eugene Monroe in January 1866 and indicated by red lines according to the course and distances given in tabular form in accompanying diagram be with chains, feet, rods or other dimensions and set apart for the use of Pah-Uts and other Indians residing there.
