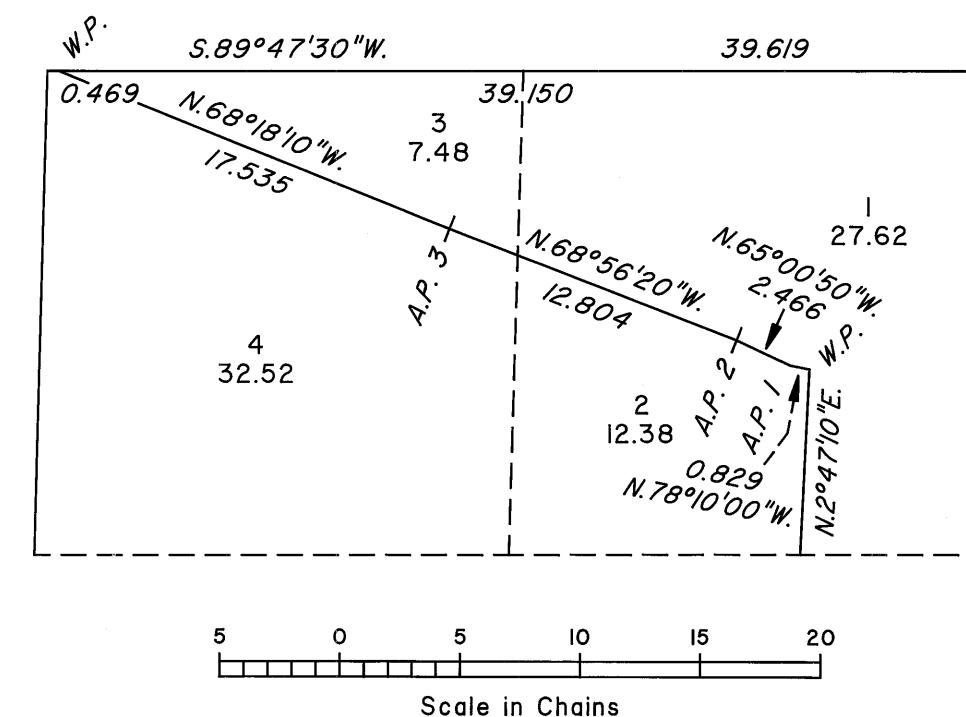


True Meridian

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, the subdivision of sections 27 and 28, the metes-and-bounds survey of the westerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 93 through portions of sections 22 and 27, and a metes-and-bounds survey in section 22, Township 20 North, Range 64 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 15, 1872 and the plat accepted January 27, 1971.
