

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION



The dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary of T. 22 N., R. 20 E. was executed concurrently under this same Group.

This plat, in two sheets, represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary of T. 22 N., R. 19 E., a portion of the subdivisional lines and portions of the segregation surveys of certain mineral claims, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 35, Township 22 North, Range 20 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

For those lines not showing bearings and distances refer to the prior official records.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 30, 1872, the plat approved February 19, 1907, the plats approved March 18, 1926 and accepted August 19, 1934, and the plat approved October 18, 1934 and accepted December 20, 1934.

Unless otherwise indicated in the field notes, all courses and distances shown on the plat along the perimeter of the mineral segregation areas were taken or computed from the appropriate segregation surveys of 1924.
