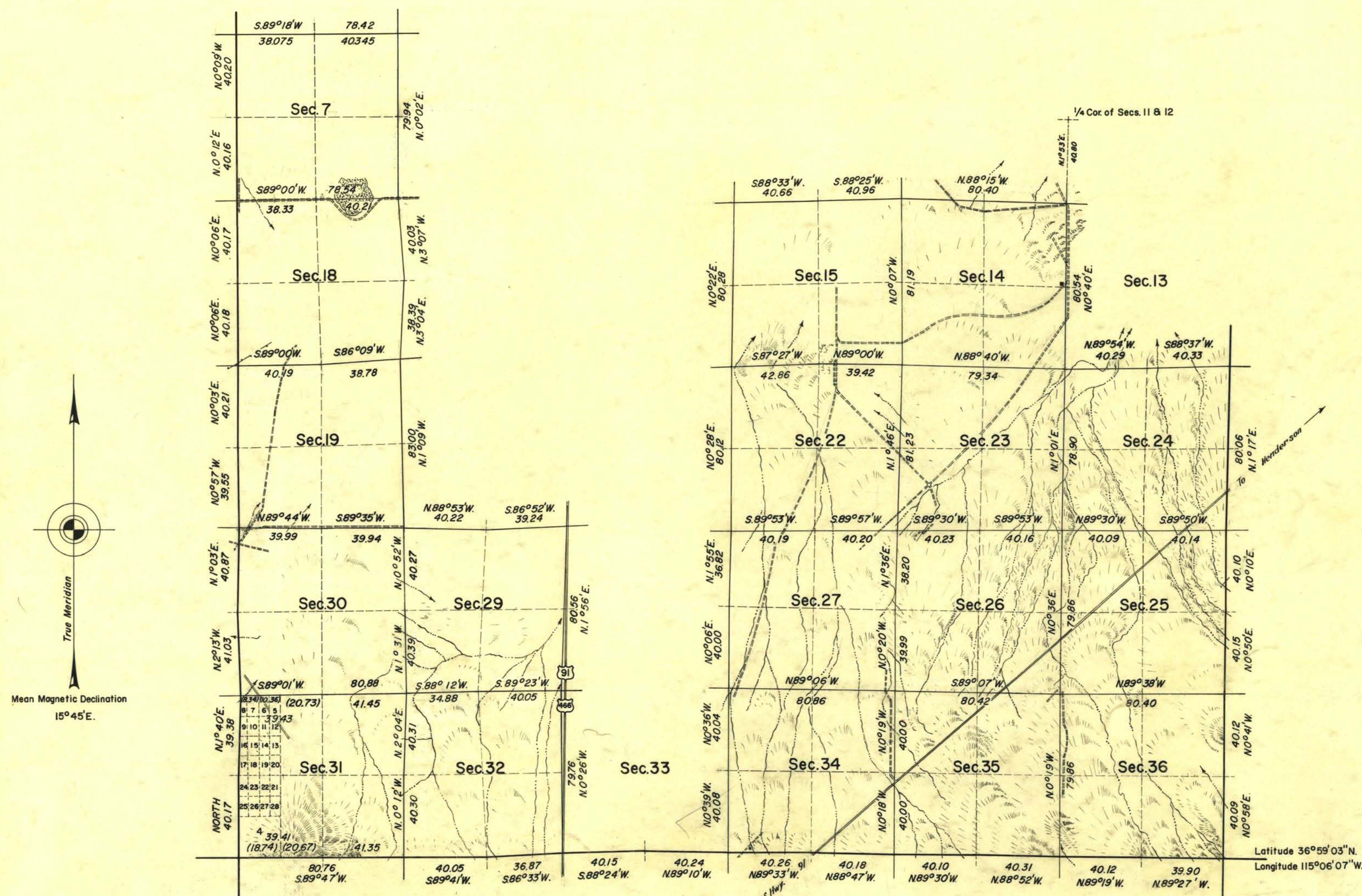


TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 61 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 22 S., R. 61 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. Lottings in secs. 7, 18, 19, and 30 are shown on Sheets 2 and 3.

Survey executed by Horace G. Parker, January 16 to 31, 1956, under special instructions dated December 15, 1955 for Group 364, Nevada.
