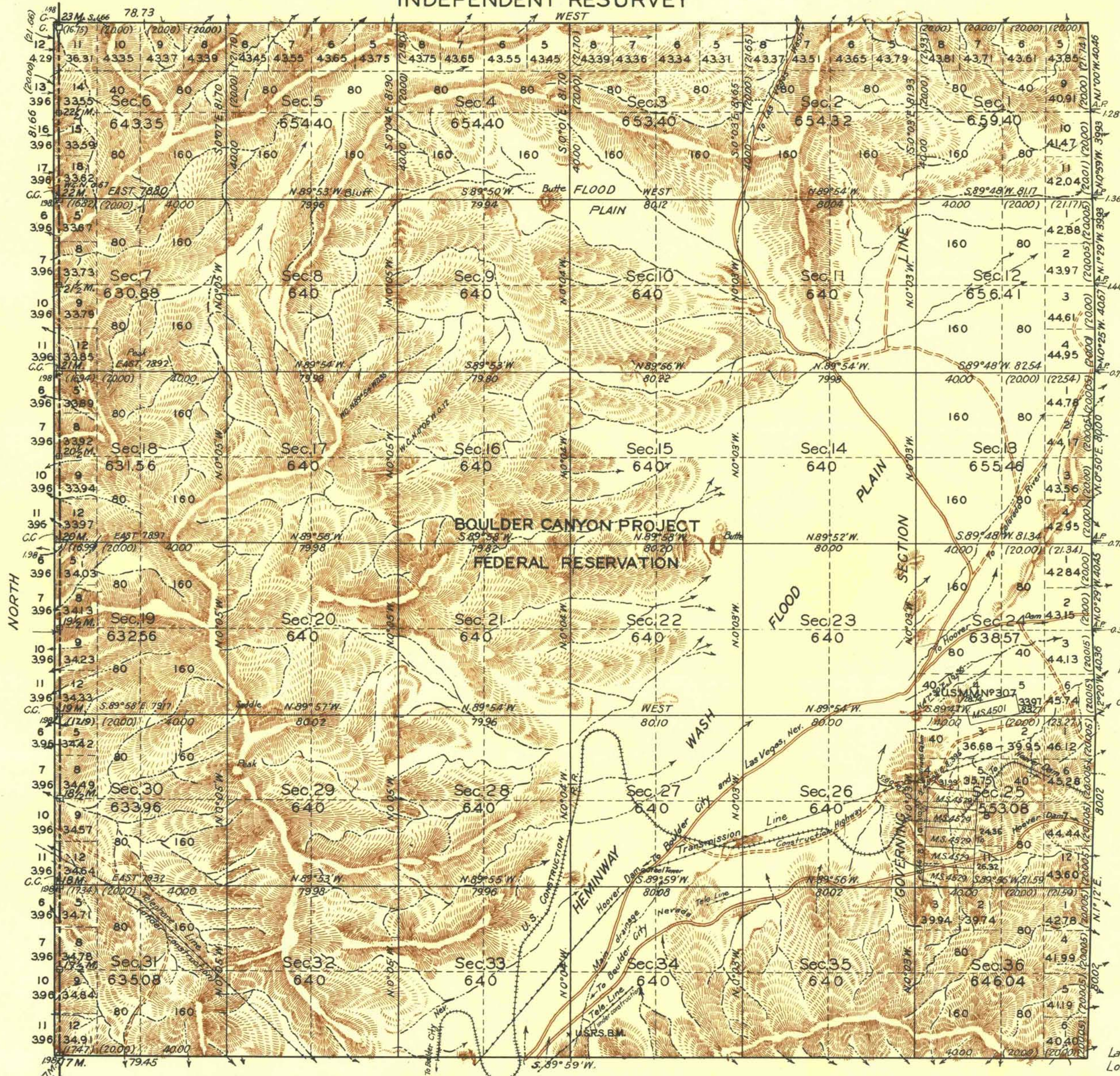


TOWNSHIP N°22 SOUTH, RANGE N°64 EAST OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.
