SUBJECT: Location of Mineral Monument No. 1, Warm Springs Mining District,
Eastern Nevada

Frank Lewis, 6904 Woodman Ave., Van Nuys, California, was in the office this morning. He stated that he had found the subject mineral monument from which the patented Nettie McCurdy Lode M.S. 37 A&B was surveyed. From our aerial photographs and the use of the plat of survey for T. 23 N., R. 67 E., we were able to locate the mineral monument. It is located on the prominent limestone peak located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2, T. 23 N., R. 67 E. The plat of survey shows a peak in this location. For further reference, corner No. 2 of the Nettie McCurdy Lode is located by intersection of the following two bearings:

From corner of Tippet Post Office the corner No. 2 bearing N30°45'W. From Warm Springs located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 14, corner No. 2 bears N3°E. These bearings were taken with a brunton compass using a declination of 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E.

Further reference may be made to our aerial photographs AA-4 and 16860. You may wish to locate this mineral monument for the records improvement project.
