
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 58 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

RETRACEMENT AND PARTIAL DEPENDENT RESURVEY



The township and subdivisional lines were surveyed by Brunt and Proctor in 1881.

This plat represents a retracement and partial dependent resurvey of the Sixth Standard Parallel South through R. 58 E. and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 24 S., R. 58 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. Areas are as shown on plat approved September 9, 1881. Broken lines and related data shown on this plat represent retracement data only, for the purpose of showing the relationship between identified corners in this township and T. 25 S., R. 58 E. See field notes for further details.

This plat also shows the definite location and resurvey of M.S. 1921 "Crosstone Lode" in sec. 31, recorded as in sec. 30, T. 25 S., R. 58 E., as shown by plat approved December 7, 1900 which was canceled July 17, 1936.
