

ENLARGED DIAGRAM OF SECTIONS 20 AND 29

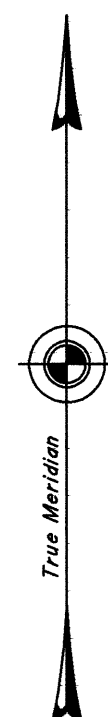
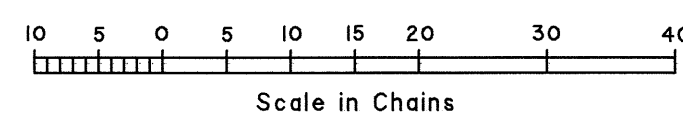
