

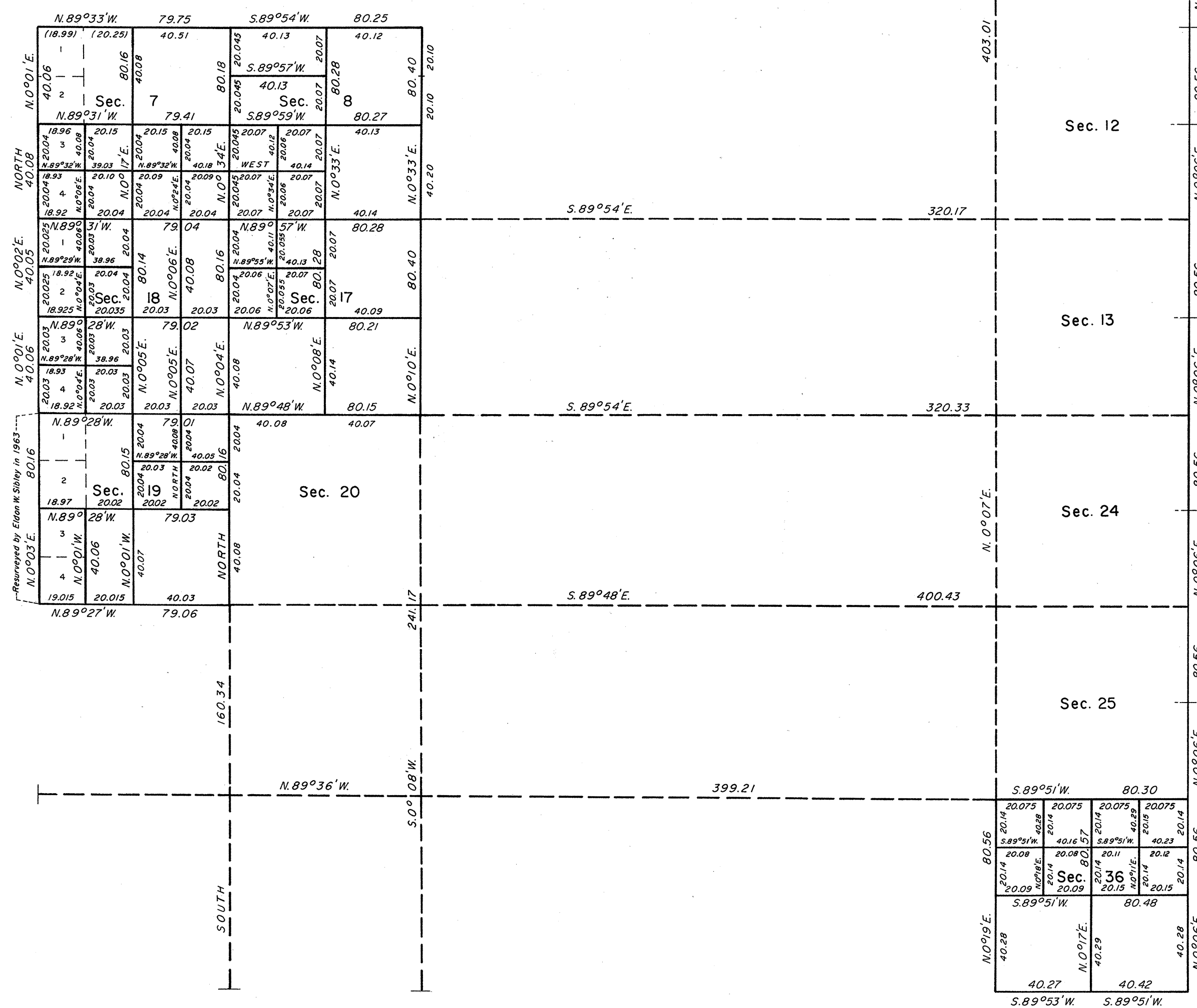

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of the north and east boundaries, a portion of the south boundary, and a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of secs. 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, and 36, T. 28 N., R. 62 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 2, 1882.
