

TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 56 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

DEPENDENT RESURVEY

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary, west boundary (Ruby Valley Guide Meridian), north and east boundaries and subdivisional lines of T. 37 N., R. 56 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Except as shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved October 26, 1872, and July 9, 1891.

Survey executed by Neil R. Forsyth and Duane R. Garoutte, Cadastral Surveyors, September 17 to October 13, 1975, under Special Instructions dated April 11, 1975, for Group No. 521, Nevada.

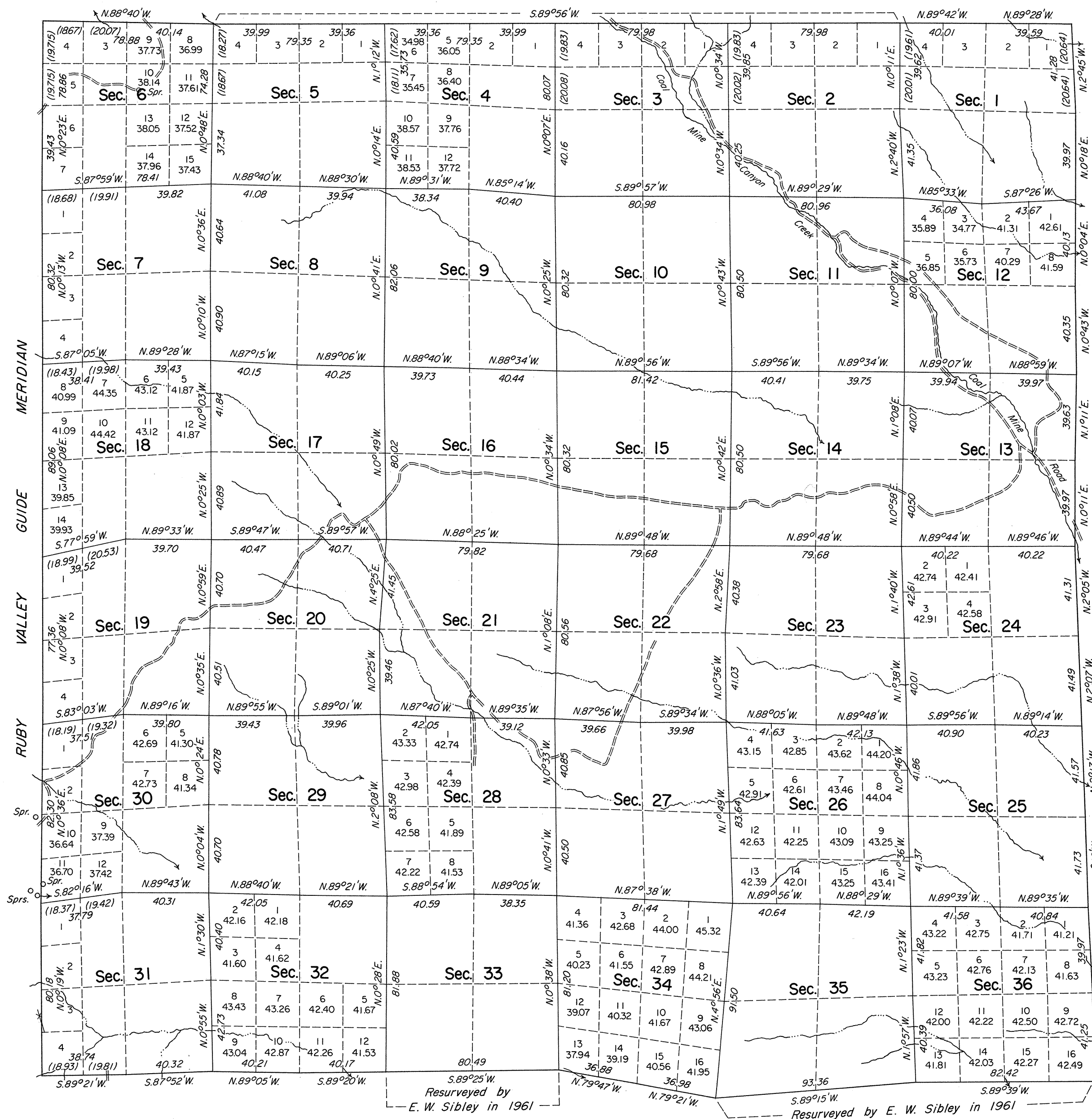
