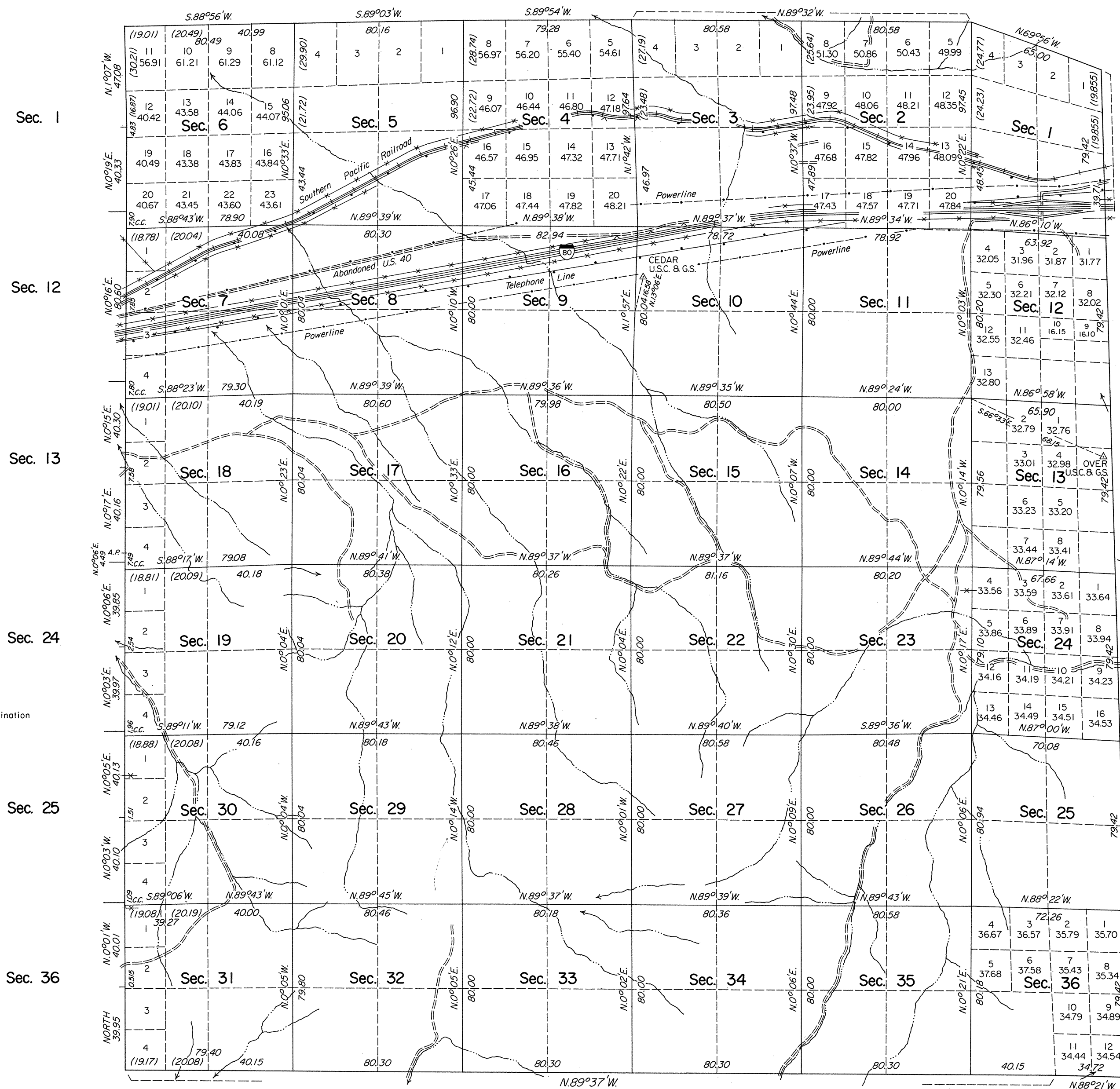


TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 63 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA
DEPENDENT RESURVEY

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

A dependent resurvey of the east boundary was executed under T. 37 N., R. 64 E., of this group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 37 N., R. 62 E., and the north and south boundaries and subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 37 N., R. 63 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved March 21, 1884.

Survey executed by Michael R. Collie and James R. Munson, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning July 26, 1976, and completed August 5, 1977, pursuant to Special Instructions dated March 22, 1976, for Group No. 533, Nevada.
