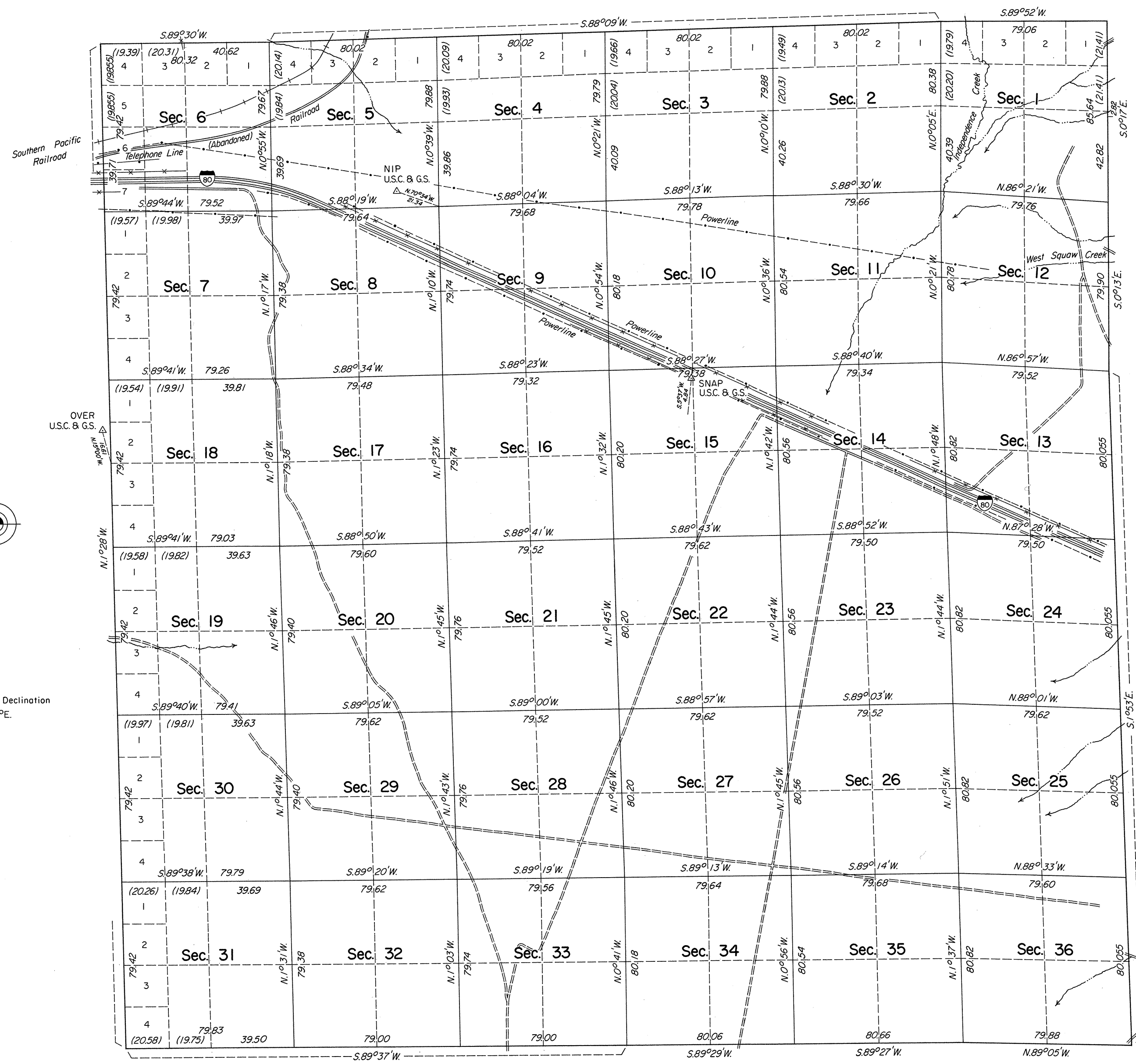


TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 64 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the north, south and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T. 37 N., R. 64 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved February 16, 1880.
