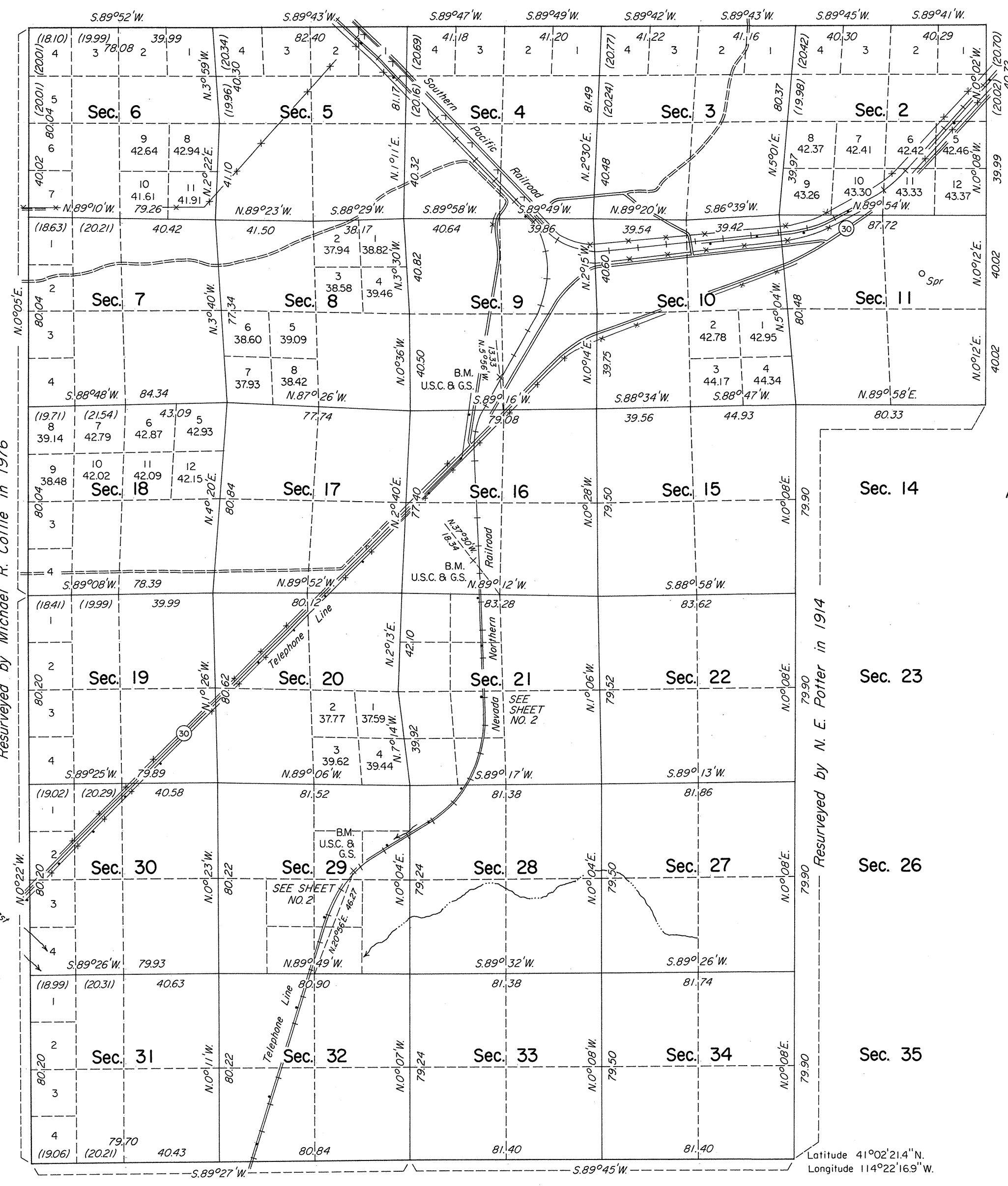


# TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 67 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary was executed concurrently under T. 36 N., R. 67 E. of this group.

Sec. 3  
This plat, in two sheets, represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 37 N., R. 67 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 2, 1880.

Areas shown in parentheses are derived from dependent resurvey data and are for administrative purposes only. Boundaries of the legal subdivision containing parenthetical acreages are in no way altered.

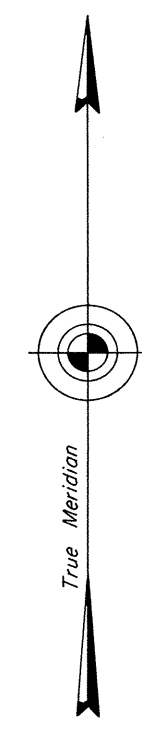

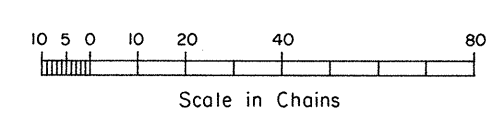
