

TOWNSHIP N°38 NORTH, RANGE N°48 EAST OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA. DEPENDENT RESURVEY



Note:

This plat of the resurvey of T.38N,R.48E, delineates a retracement and reestablishment of the lines of the original survey as shown upon the plat approved March 31, 1885, in their true original position according to the best available evidence of the position of the original corners; all differences between the measurements shown on the original plat and those derived in the retracement have been distributed proportionally between accepted corners in accordance with surveying rules; reference will be made to the original plat for the showing of the areas and more detailed descriptions of the various smaller subdivisions, except that the recomputed areas under the resurvey for Secs. 12 and 13 are as indicated on this plat.

U.S. Engineer reports indications of cinnabar in Secs. 19, 20, 32 and 33. Prospects were noticed in the south half and north-west parts of the township.
