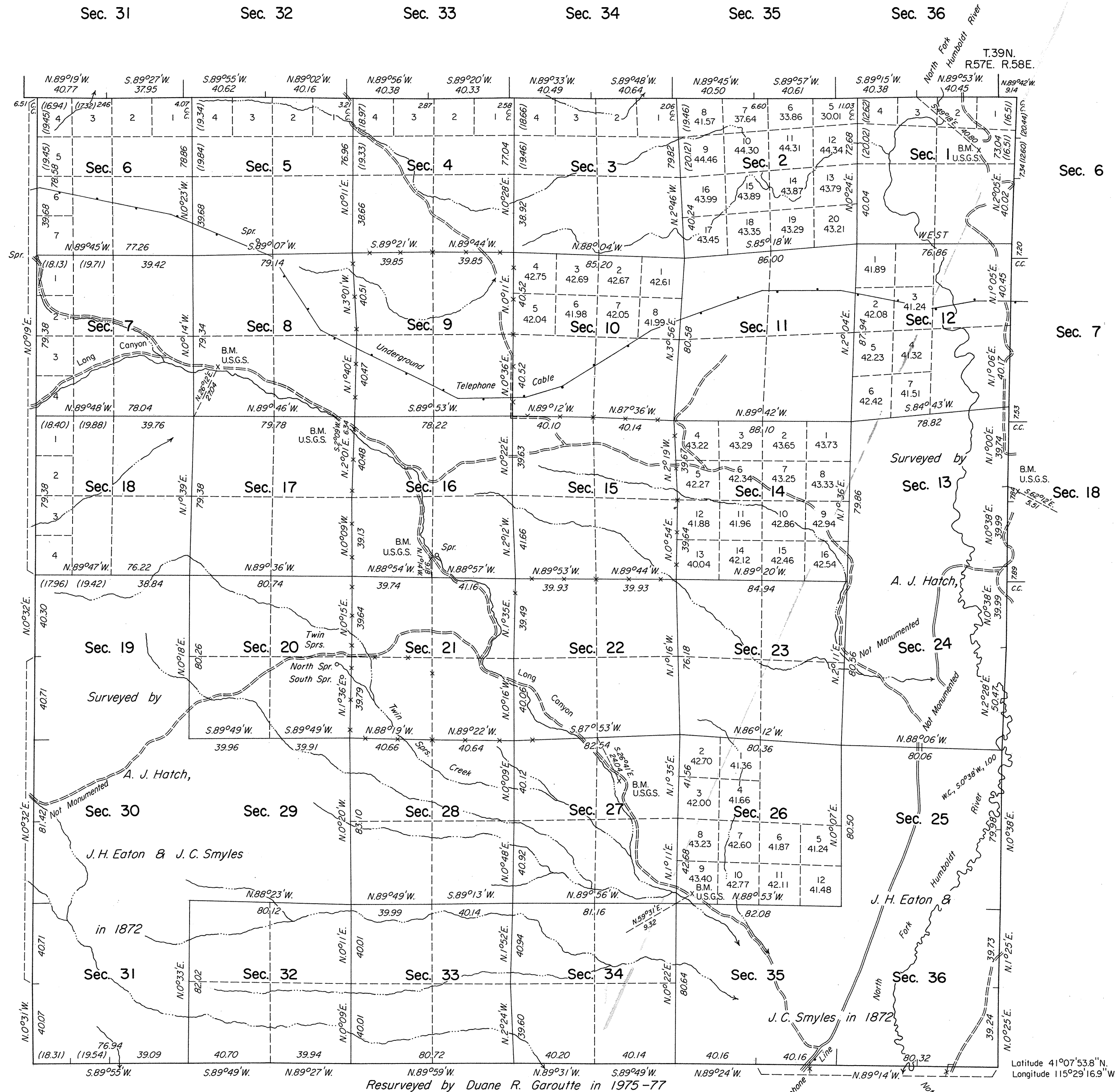

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the north boundary, a portion of the west and east boundaries, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, in T. 38 N., R. 57 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as shown hereon, lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 26, 1872, and July 9, 1891.
