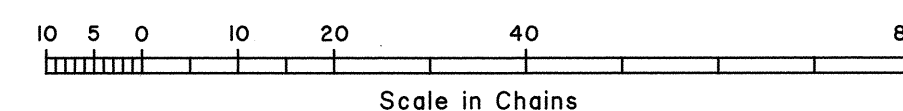

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 26, Township 38 North, Range 59 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 8, 1880.

For those surveyed lines not showing bearings and distances, refer to the official 1880 and 1980 surveys.
