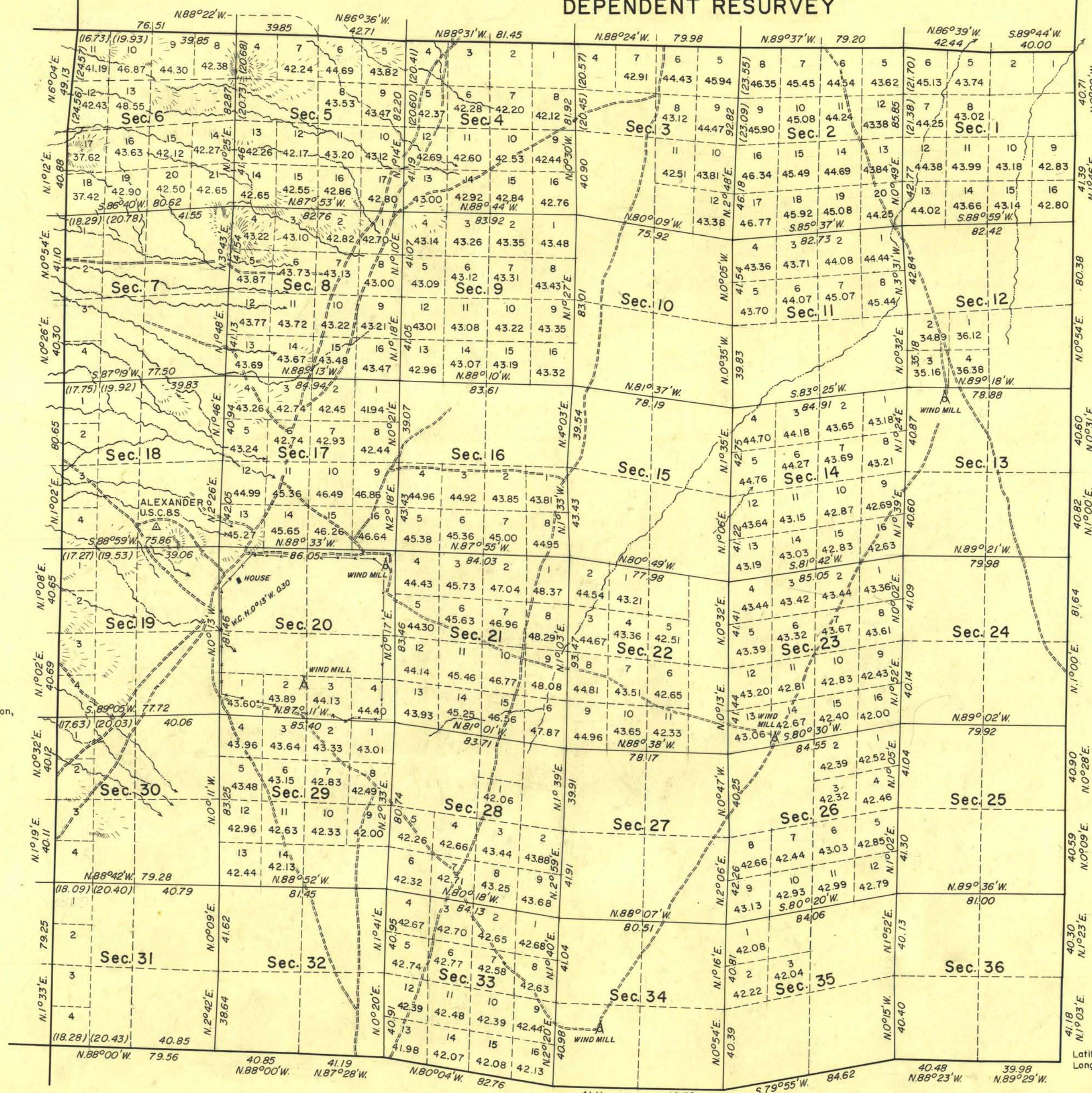
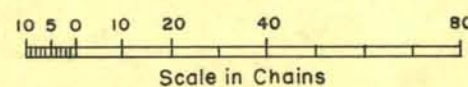

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T. 39 N., R. 33 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original positions according to the best available evidence; except as shown hereon, lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved November 16, 1874.

Surveys shown hereon were executed by Lacel E. Bland, from June 21 to July 19, 1960, under special instructions, dated June 15, 1960, for Group 391, Nevada.
