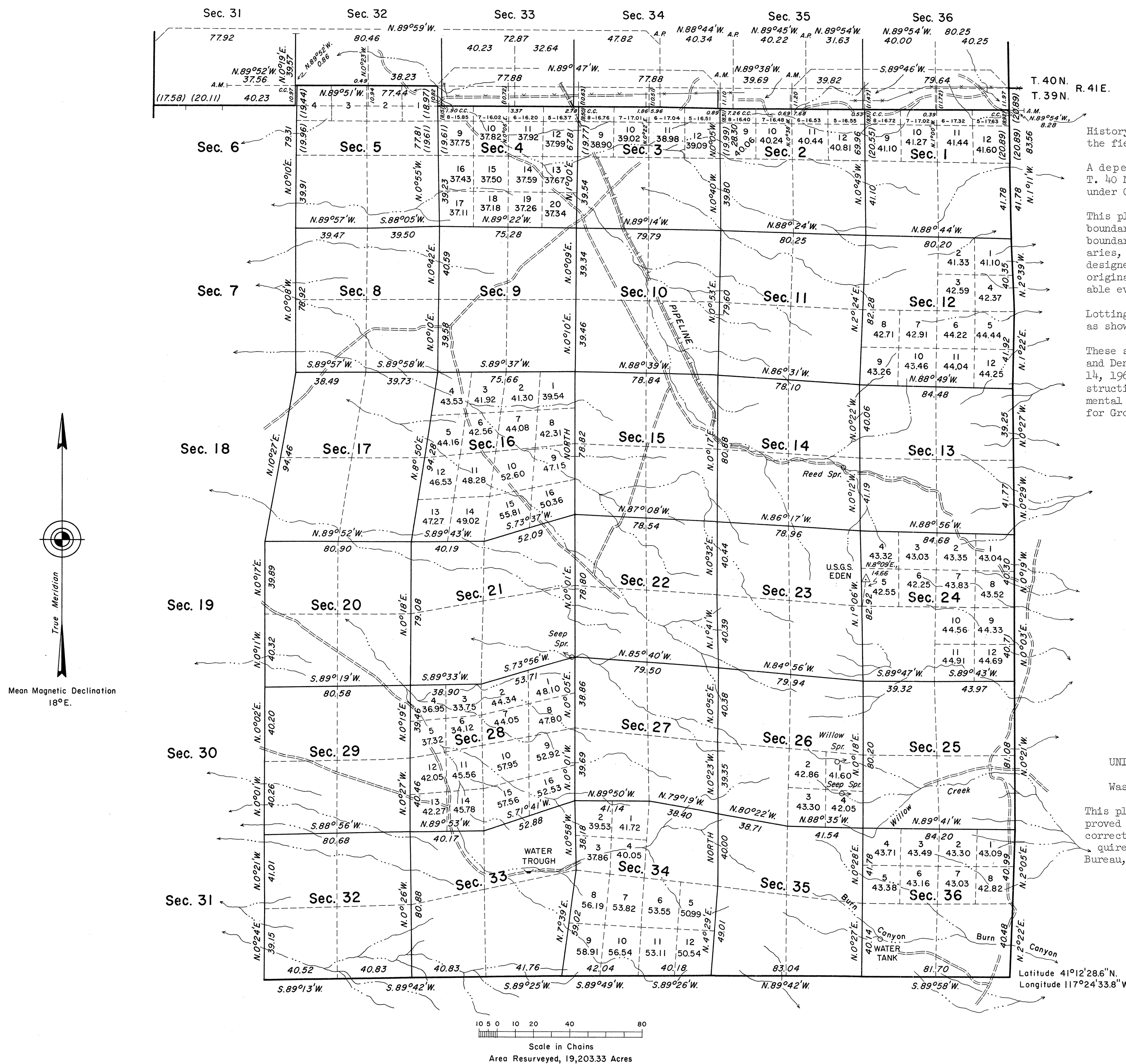

History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

A dependent resurvey of the south boundary of T. 40 N., R. 40 E., was executed concurrently under Group No. 421.

This plat represents the retracement of the north boundary, the dependent resurvey of the east boundary, portions of the north and south boundaries, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore all corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Lottings and areas (except as shown hereon) are as shown on the plat approved January 20, 1891.

These surveys were executed by Lancel E. Bland and Dennis D. Bland, Cadastral Surveyors, June 14, 1966, to August 16, 1966, under Special Instructions dated November 5, 1965, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated July 12, 1966, for Group No. 432, Nevada.
