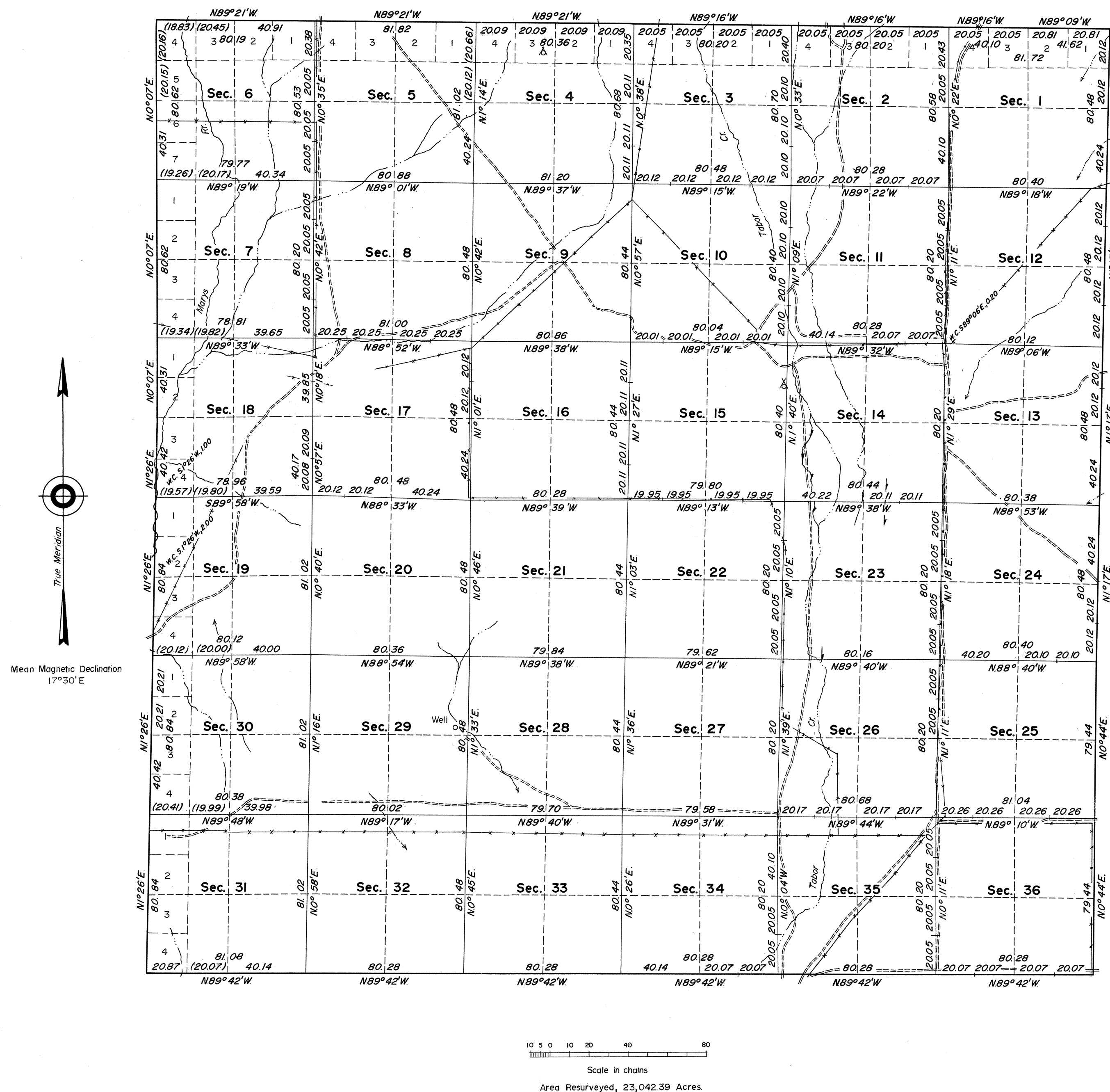


TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 60 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the north, east, and west boundaries and subdivisional lines of T. 39 N., R. 60 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations, according to the best available evidence. Lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 8, 1880.

The south boundary was resurveyed concurrently with this group.

The survey was executed by Eldon W. Sibley, October 18 to December 10, 1962, under Special Instructions dated September 4, 1962, Group No. 405, Nevada.
