DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION

History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 41 N., R. 54 E., designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence; and the survey of the subdivision of section 33 of T. 41 N., R. 54 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved February 26, 1871.

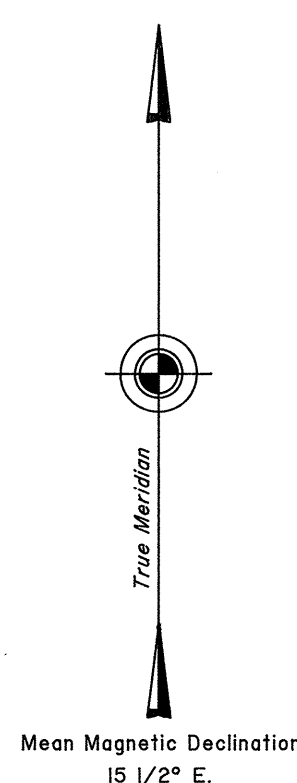
