
## TOWNSHIP 44 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 44N., R. 28 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations, according to the best available evidence. Lottings and areas are as shown upon the plat approved October 14, 1874.

The west boundary was resurveyed concurrently with this group.

The survey was executed by Lacel E. Bland, May 21 to June 4, 1962, under Special Instructions dated March 13, 1962, for Group No. 400, Nevada.
