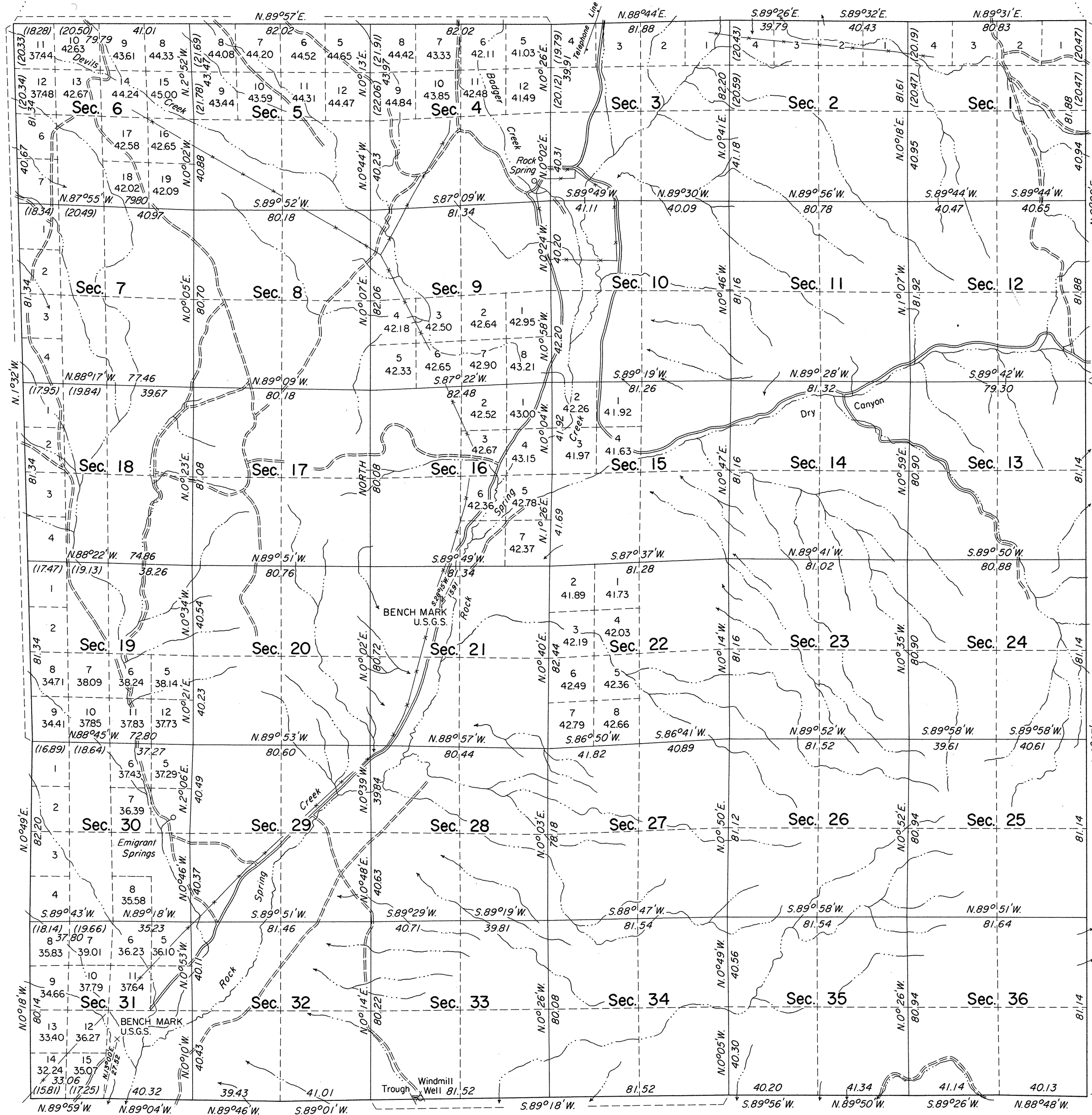


TOWNSHIP 44 NORTH, RANGE 67 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

DEPENDENT RESURVEY

Dependent Resurvey by James W. Hardison in 1941-42



History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the east, west and south boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T. 44 N., R. 67 E., designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence.

Except as indicated, lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 30, 1881.

These surveys were executed by Alburn D. Griffin, Cadastral Surveyor, and Woodrow L. Jepson, Surveying Technician, May 6 to November 7, 1968, under Special Instructions dated August 1, 1967 for Group No. 451, Nevada.
