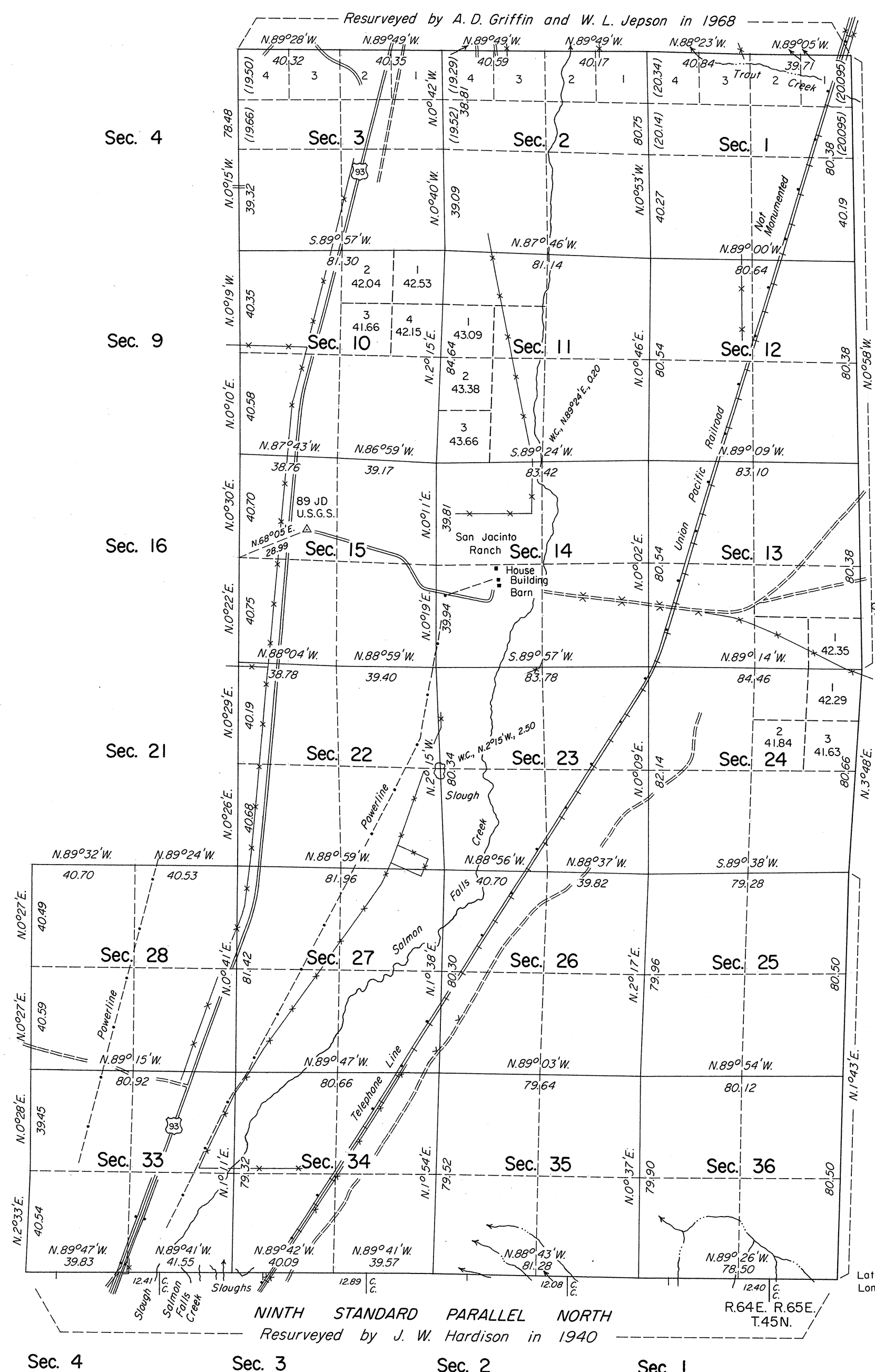

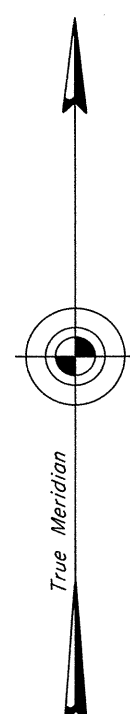


Scale in Chains
