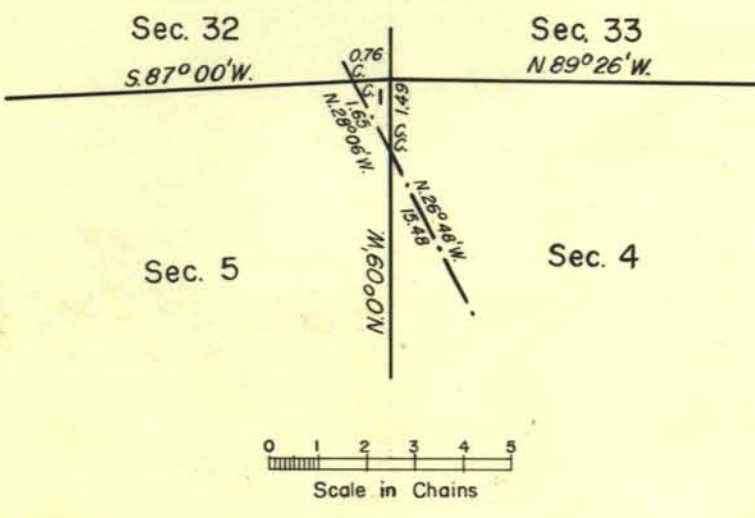
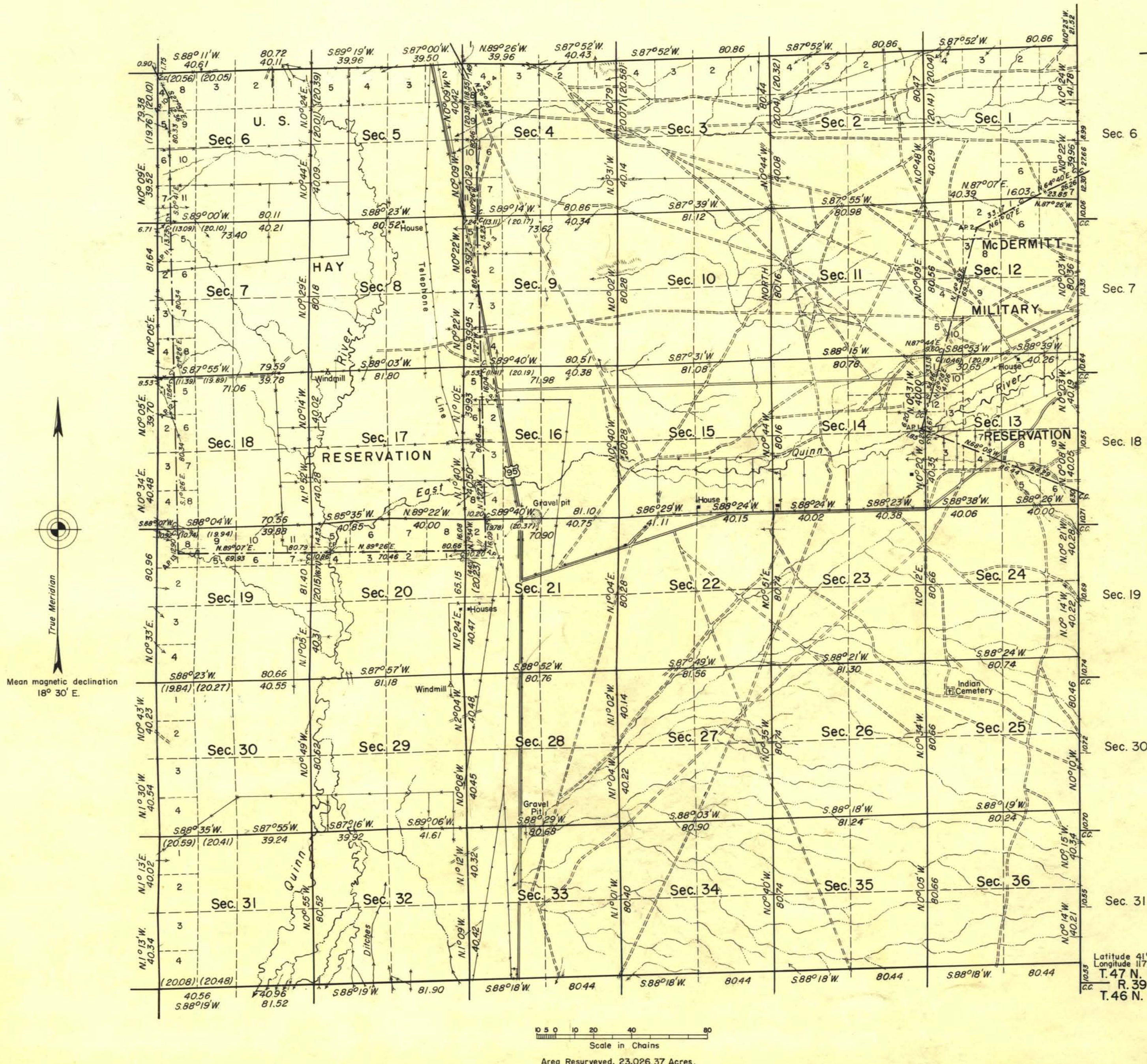


TOWNSHIP 47 NORTH, RANGE 38 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the north, east, and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T. 47 N., R. 38 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. Lottings and areas are as shown on plats approved April 4, 1891, December 4, 1891, and plat accepted April 11, 1929.
