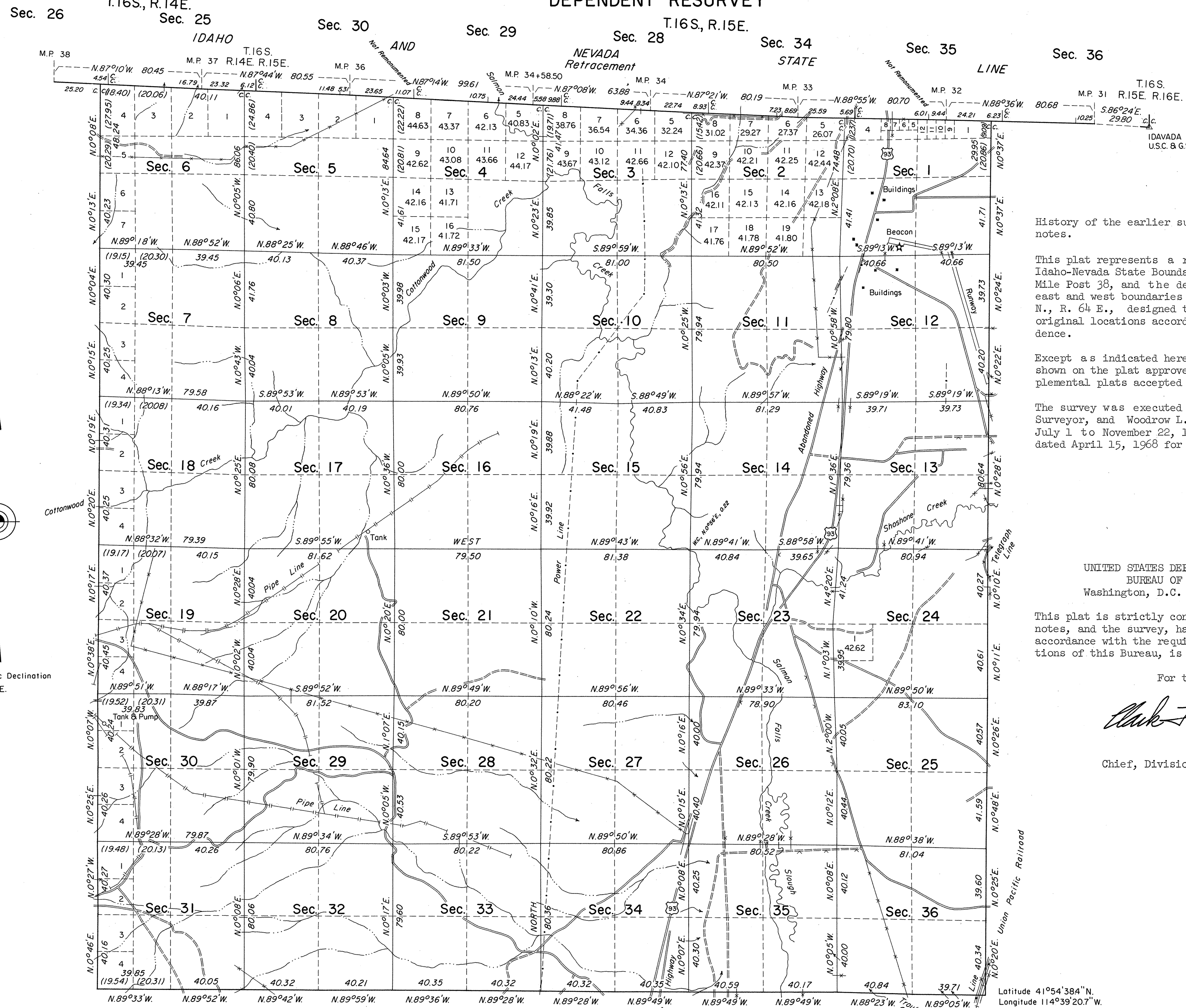


# TOWNSHIP 47 NORTH, RANGE 64 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY



History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a retracement of a portion of the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary Line from Mile Post 31 to Mile Post 38, and the dependent resurvey of the south, east and west boundaries and subdivisional lines of T. 47 N., R. 64 E., designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence.

Except as indicated hereon, lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 19, 1881, and the supplemental plats accepted May 14, 1948 and July 17, 1959.

The survey was executed by Alburn D. Griffin, Cadastral Surveyor, and Woodrow L. Jepson, Surveying Technician, July 1 to November 22, 1968, under Special Instructions dated April 15, 1968 for Group No. 457, Nevada.
