

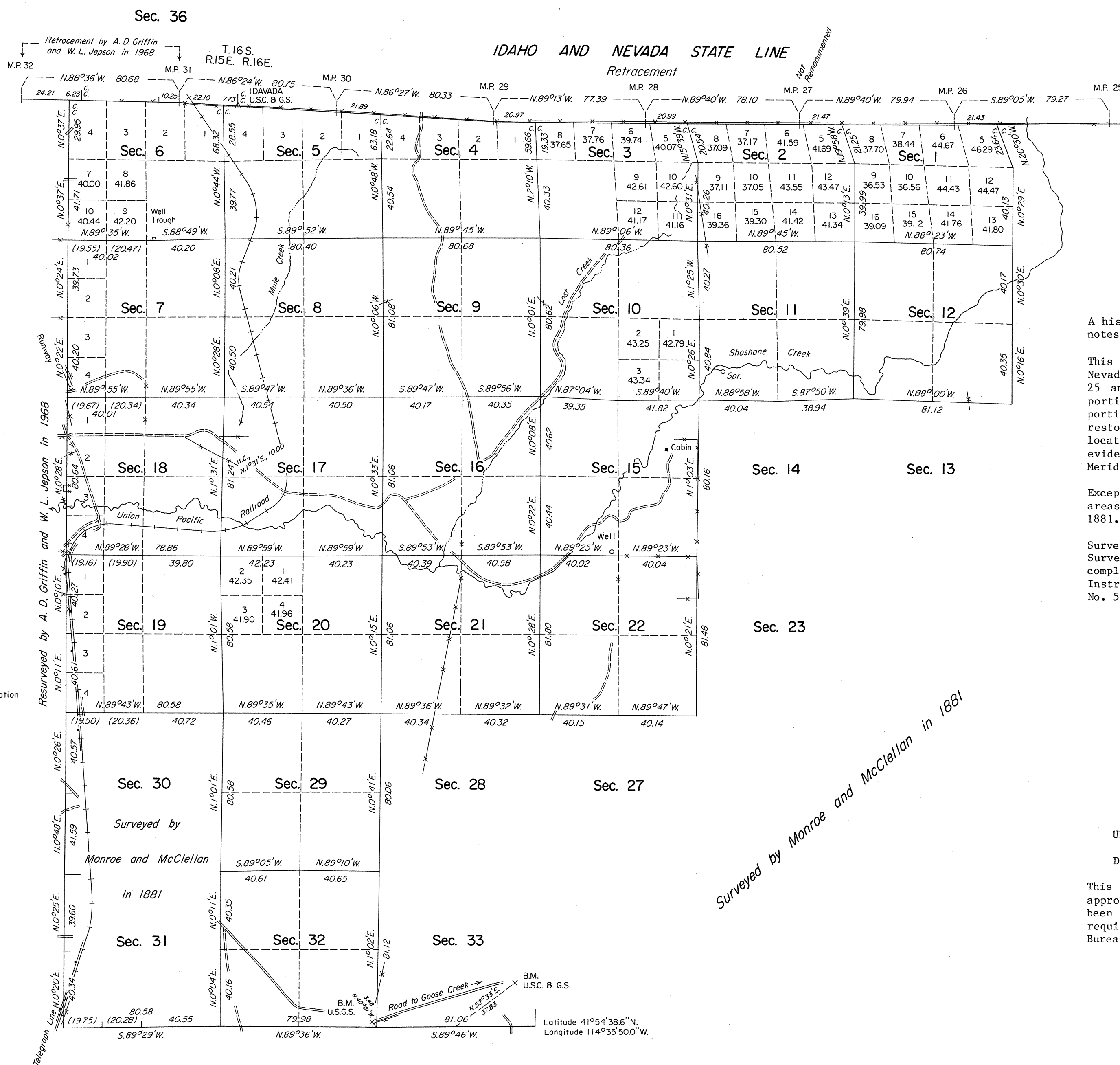

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a retracement of the Nevada-Idaho State Line between Mile Post Nos. 25 and 31, and the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south and east boundaries and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 47 N., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved May 5, 1881.

Survey executed by Neil R. Forsyth, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning August 11, 1977, and completed October 6, 1977, pursuant to Special Instructions dated August 3, 1977, for Group No. 554, Nevada.
