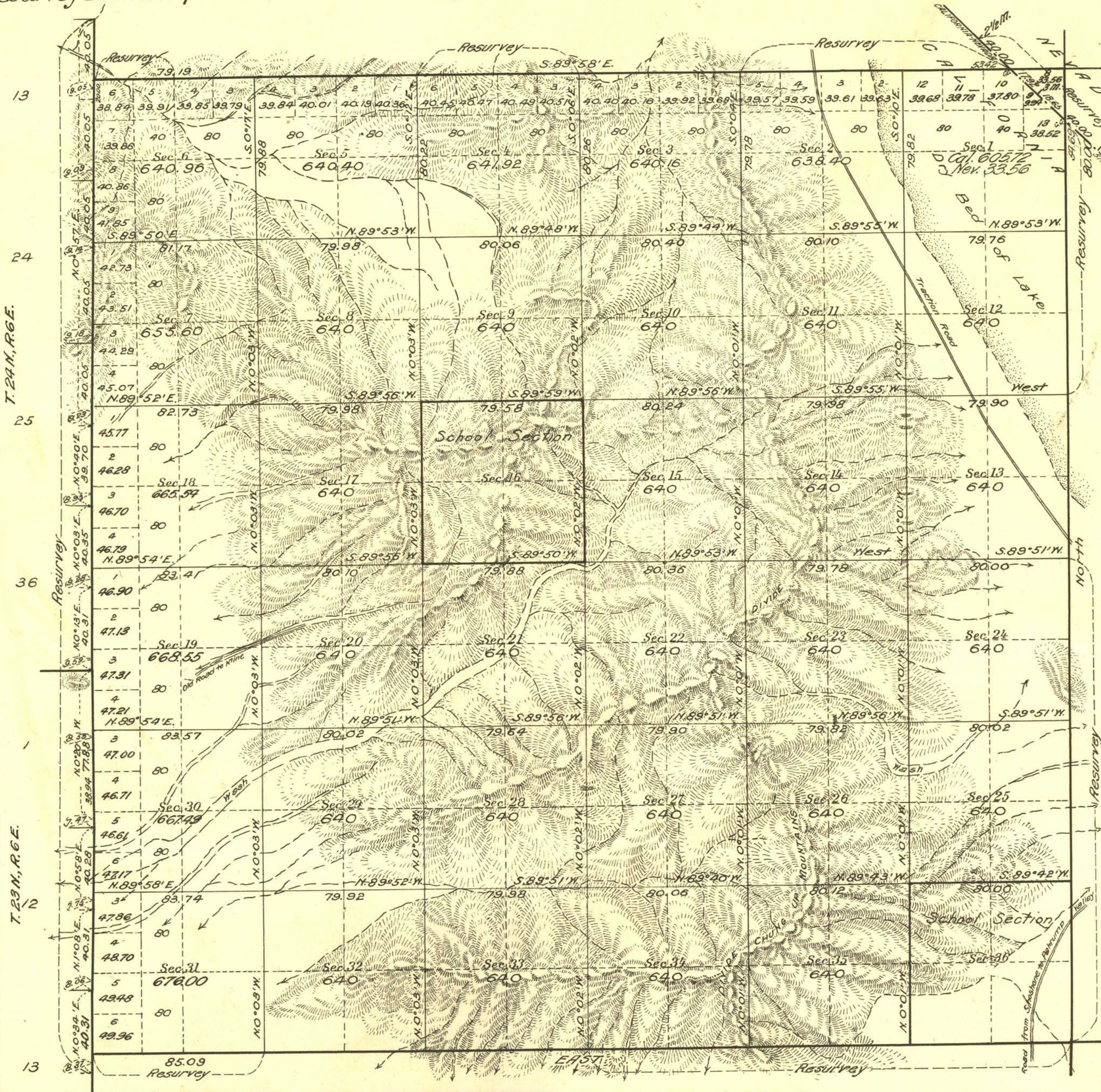


Survey and Resurvey Township No. 24 North, Range No. 7 East, San Bernardino Meridian, California and Nevada
