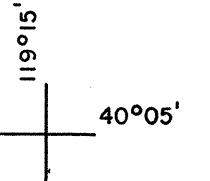
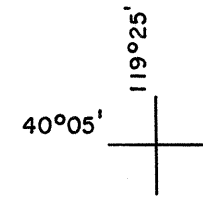


NEVADA PROTRACTION DIAGRAM

Tps. 25 N., Rs. 23 and 24 E.

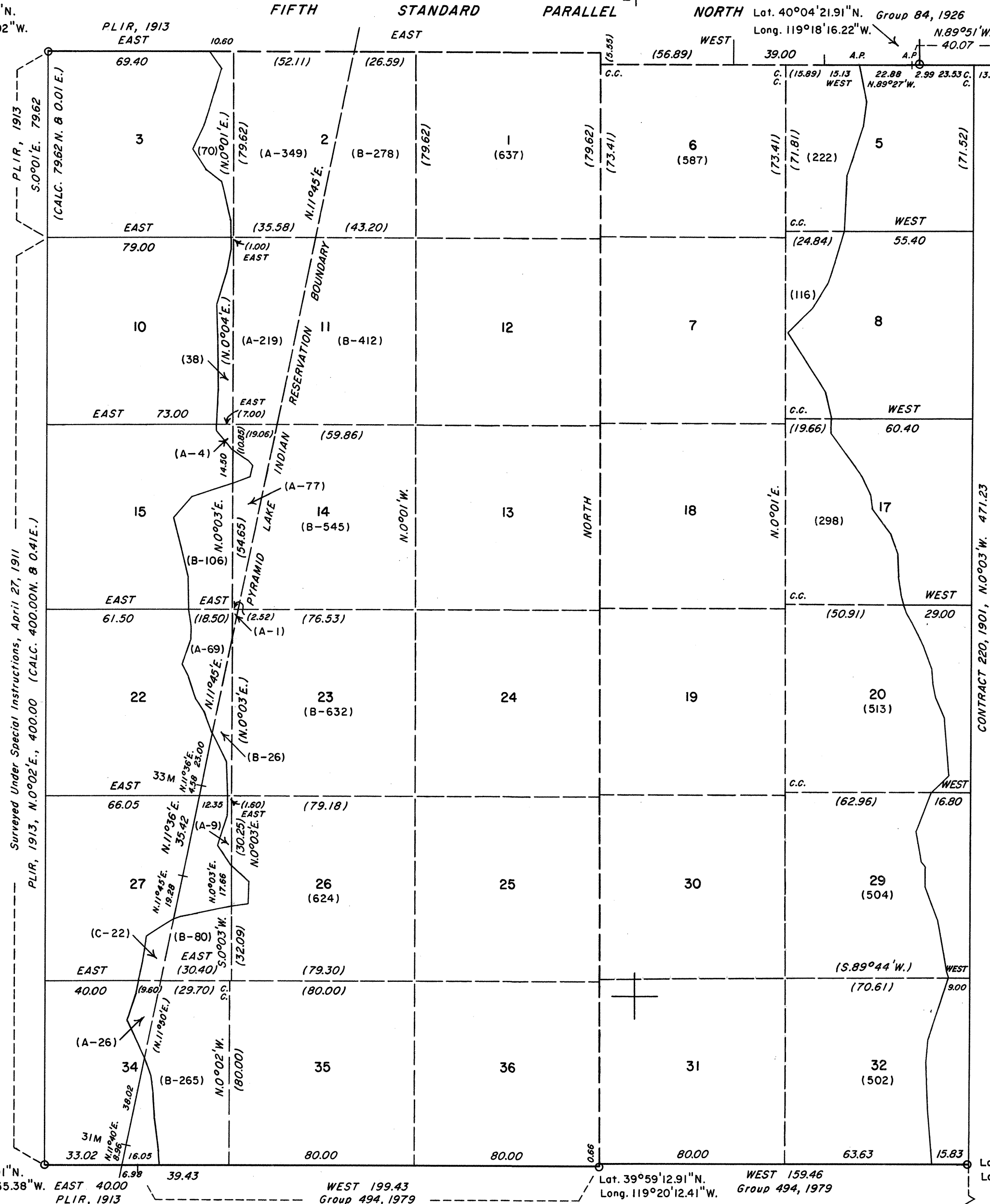

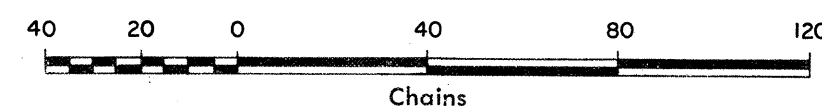
